




CHECKLIST FOR A CRUISE





CHECKLIST

Travel Documents:

- Passport or other acceptable identification
- Cruise tickets or e-tickets
- Visa or other entry requirements (if applicable)
- Travel insurance documents

Packing Essentials:

- Clothing: Pack a variety of outfits suitable for the cruise's destination and activities, including formal attire for formal nights if required.
- Swimwear and cover-ups
- Comfortable shoes for walking and exploring
- Formal attire (if required)
- Lightweight jacket or sweater for cooler evenings
- Toiletries: Toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, soap, etc.
- Medications: Pack any necessary prescription medications and basic first aid supplies.
- Electronics: Don't forget chargers, adapters, and any other electronic devices you may want to bring.
- Travel-sized sunscreen and insect repellent
- Travel-sized laundry detergent (if needed)
- Snacks or preferred food items (check cruise line policies regarding outside food)
- Travel-sized umbrella or rain jacket
- Travel-sized power strip or extension cord (check cruise line policies)
- Travel-sized iron or wrinkle release spray (check cruise line policies)

Money and Financial Essentials:

- Sufficient cash and/or credit/debit cards
- Notify your bank and credit card companies about your travel plans to avoid any issues with card usage.
- Small bills for tips and small purchases

Health and Safety:

- Travel insurance: Consider purchasing travel insurance to protect against unforeseen circumstances.
- Prescription medications and copies of prescriptions
- Seasickness remedies, if needed
- Hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes

Important Information:

- Emergency contact numbers
- Contact information for the cruise line or travel agent
- Itinerary details
- Any pre-booked excursions or activities

Miscellaneous Items:

- Travel-sized laundry bag
- Travel-sized sewing kit
- Travel-sized alarm clock or phone alarm
- Travel-sized guidebooks or maps
- Reading materials or entertainment for downtime
- Reusable water bottle
